

First Sunday of Advent 27th November 2022

A new year begins with Advent AND it is the longest Advent possible with four full weeks! More time to prepare or to worry? Longer to wait or deeper, lasting anticipation? Joy and fruitfulness or panic and despondency? We go through so many different kinds of emotion in this season; our batteries may be drained as we attempt to meet the expectations of so many!

Last Thursday I had an opportunity to go to a pre-Advent Retreat Day with other Diocesan priests. It was led by the Ukranian Eparch (Bishop) Kenneth Nowakowski and it took place at the Ukranian Cathedral of the Holy Family which is just off Oxford Street in London. What a day I had! Firstly, coming off the busyness of Oxford Street with its many shoppers and Christmas lights and entering a building which once was a Congregational Church built in Romanesque style, now decorated with icons. I was with priests from a host of nations working in our Diocese, some of whom I had never met before. Bishop Kenneth explained to us that as an Eastern-Rite bishop he operates with the Julian Calendar in the Ukranian Church and with the Gregorian Calendar in other Churches. So, TWO Christmas Days (7th January 2023 AND 25th December 2022) and two sets of 'Advent'! I was starting to feel discombobulated as I imagined life with two Christmases!! On Thursday I was able to enjoy times of silence and moments of being together, amazing Ukranian food, and a chance to ponder the huge crisis that nation is facing. I was in another world and learning so much!

As we begin our Advent journey, the Church reminds us of Christ's Second Coming - his Parousia - when he will return in glory to complete all things and bring time to its conclusion. No one knows the day or the hour and we are implored to prepare well and to get things in order in our personal lives. The world also must get ready and we are signposts of what it is to come. It is very easy to fall into the trap of operating on autopilot in this season and to coast along. The danger is that we might miss the very Lord we are awaiting! By moving out of our comfort zones, we can be open to fresh experiences and new ways of letting him in. The diversity of approaches will surely enrich us and lead to an even more blessed encounter with him when we reach our destination. Who is waiting for our help? How does the Lord want to use us in Advent 2022? What are we afraid of as we try to respond to the Lord's call?

I wish you and your loved ones every blessing on this path we have undertaken. Let's support one another in prayer. With much love, *Fr. Norbert*
