I would like to take the occasion to introduce myself to the parish community as I'm starting my new appointment as an assistant priest here in Welwyn Garden City. I'm Italian from Padua, the third eldest of nine siblings. My parents brought me up to the faith since I was a child as all my family belongs to the Neocathecumenal Way which is one of the ecclesiastical realities born as a fruit of the Second Vatican Council. The Neocathecumenal Way is an ongoing itinerary of Christian initiation in faith for both young and adult people. Through it, not only I was able to experience the love of God for me through the Church, in a concrete community of people who strive to grow in faith and put into practice the Word of God, but I also saw how God has a plan of salvation and love for each person.

Therefore, little by little, I have been helped to see more clearly the presence of God in my life and to discern his will for me. This eventually led me to discern the calling of God to become a priest and brought me here to England in 2011.

After a time of formation spent discerning and preparing myself for the priesthood, I was ordained two years ago for the Diocese of Westminster. Over the past two years, I had the grace of serving as an assistant priest in the parish of Our Lady of Victories in High Street Kensington. It has been a challenging yet very rewarding experience where once again I saw the faithfulness of God and how he works through me in spite of my weaknesses and fears.

I was able to grow in confidence and joy in the priestly ministry he entrusted to me and I'm eager to start serving in this parish community. To him be the glory. I look forward to getting to know you. Please pray for me. **Fr. Marco**
