

Fifth Sunday of Lent 3rd April 2022

Today's Gospel reading from St. John begins with total mayhem as a woman caught sinning is dragged before the Lord as a test. The passage ends with the silent joy of the lady as she leaves the Lord's presence having been forgiven and she can make a new start in her life. This is a parable of Lent in our lives as we ponder God's gracious love and are open to accepting reconciliation. Just think back to last Sunday's Gospel of the Prodigal Son!

What has gone wrong in your life? Which burdens are you carrying this year in Lent? How are you struggling with life, with faith, with what is happening in the world? Many people wonder what Jesus was writing on the ground with his finger. Perhaps he was listing the sins of the woman's accusers? Maybe he was drawing a picture of the God of mercy and compassion? Could it be the Cross in two strokes summing up the Sacrifice he would make? Think about yourself and allow the Lord to look into your heart; he sees possibilities, a way forward, and he carries our crosses on his shoulder. Reflect on the gift of the Sacrament of Reconciliation which he left us and search for words to express your need of his grace. Come to Confession and celebrate the mercy he pours out. Extend your hand to others to give them support and a concrete experience of God's presence.

Finally, picture the lady from the Gospel: the silent realisation that she has not been condemned, the joy welling up in her heart that God has accepted her and the deep peace from having encountered Divine Love in Jesus. There's not long to go in our Lenten journey. Don't lose any opportunity to meet the Lord! God bless you.

EARLY MORNING MASS There were around 40 people (including a dozen children) last Friday at 6.30 with most staying for a hearty breakfast! We will definitely continue next month on 6th May.

LENT GROUP The Lent Group met on Thursday evening at Holy Family Church. We explored the idea of Mary as Help of Christians and how she can inspire us to make our lives an offering to God. We also discussed the importance of praying the rosary. Next week will be our final meeting.

SERVICE OF RECONCILIATION on Tuesday 12th April at 8pm in Our Lady's. There will be reflection on Scripture for about 10 minutes and then 3 visiting priests will join Fr. Norbert and Fr. William to hear Confessions. There's time to stop, think and ponder, time to make your Confession and experience the riches of God's mercy in this sacramental way AND the opportunity to go to a priest you do not know (if you prefer)! People leave once they have gone to the priest for Confession. Put the date in your diary. Parents bring your children. Let's avail of this moment in Holy Week to feel the closeness of the Lord to us in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
