Last Wednesday I had the great fortune of going to Buckingham Palace for a Garden Party. I was not really sure what to expect but in the end it turned out to be a thoroughly enjoyable afternoon. I set off with a friend who was ordained two weeks after me. We queued at the gates of the Palace and finally entered the grand building and walked into the gardens. My cousin's next-door neighbour came running up to me. I had to get her to remind me who she was! I then bumped into parishioners of St. Bonaventure's, followed by one of the local councillors. As we waited for the Queen to walk by, the man behind me said he knew the rabbi of the synagogue in the Garden City. I also spotted a group of Salvation Army people a distance away and asked where they were from. On being told 'Elephant and Castle', I proceeded to inform them that their 'Top Man' in the whole country was coming to one of my churches in Welwyn Garden City, to which the riposte was 'I AM the Top Man!' I later found out that he is the Territorial Commander coming to Our Lady's for a service on 2nd June. The Queen walked by just a couple of yards from where I was standing; later I saw the Duke of Edinburgh and also the Duchess of Cambridge (Kate Middleton). My friend and I had a chance to wander through the gardens, to eat cucumber sandwiches and sip cups of tea. What a tremendous experience!

Sadly, while we were in the grounds of the Palace, terror was at work in Woolwich. It is unbelievable to think what was going on not far away. Let us pray for the soldier murdered and for his grieving family. Let us offer our prayers for those who feel very insecure because of the atrocity and for the healing of minds which have been radicalised.

May God the Father give us peace. May Jesus Christ the Son of God bring reconciliation. May the Holy Spirit guide us forward away from the darkness of recent events.
