

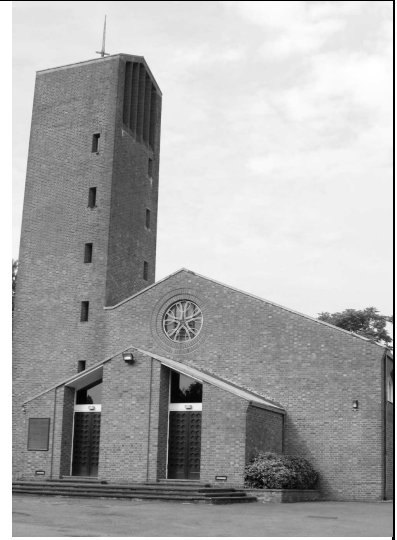

## ***The Ascension of the Lord 1st June 2014 (page 272)***

We start a new month! Public examinations will begin in earnest this week. Summer is on its way? We are *still* in Eastertide with the joy and glory of Resurrection shining upon us. Today we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord: Jesus, the Son of God, who suffered, died and rose for us, is seated at the Father's Right Hand. He has not left us alone; there is the Promise of the Holy Spirit still to come. The amazing thing about our Saviour is that he chooses to help us keep experiencing his Presence: 'I am with you always, yes, to the end of time' are the closing words from today's passage which marks the conclusion of St. Matthew's Gospel.

How do YOU know he is still with you? Do you read the Scriptures as well as listening to them proclaimed in church? What does the Real Presence of Jesus in Holy Communion mean to you when you come to Mass or pay a visit to church to pray before the Tabernacle? How does gathering with the Christian Community on Sunday for the Eucharist enrich your life and support you daily as you live out your vocation? As a priest, I am called on to speak Christ's words at Mass, recalling what he said at the Last Supper and effecting the Consecration of the bread and wine; I proclaim his Good News and unpack it in the homily. It is awesome! Trying to live out each day the responsibility entrusted to me is a great privilege and challenge. Jesus is with us every moment of each day. The heightened awareness we have of his Presence at Mass should prepare us for the wonderful ways he breaks into our lives - he is really present with us.

Take a moment today at Mass to consider also what the future glory of heaven will be like - the eternal joy of seeing him face to face...the everlasting experience of being with Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The Ascension keeps us in touch with Jesus Christ at the Father's Right Hand in the Trinity and with Jesus Christ still with us on earth. God bless your week as we journey towards Pentecost next week and the completion of the Easter Mystery. *Fr. Norbert*

**MASS WITH ANOINTING OF THE SICK** on Saturday 14th June at 12noon in Our Lady's organised by the SVP for our three parishes. The Sacrament of the Sick is a powerful expression of Church's love for, and care of, those who are seriously ill or infirm. The priest lays his hands the person's head and then anoints the forehead and the palms of the hands with Holy Oil blessed by the Cardinal. Our prayer is that the sick will get better and that the infirm will be strengthened; however, with confidence, we ask God to watch over those who are nearing the end of their lives and to give them peace and hope. Many of us need healing for a whole variety of reasons, some which are obvious, some which lie hidden to others. Come and share in this great act of prayer and ministry for members of our community who seek Christ's healing touch. Afterwards there will be a gathering in the hall with refreshments. On Saturday 14th there will not be the usual 10am Mass at St. Bonaventure's or Confessions.
