



Most Holy Trinity 15h June 2014 (page 81)

We have now returned to Ordinary Time but it will be a number of weeks before we see green on Sundays. Today we celebrate the Holy Trinity; next week it will be Corpus Christi; then on 29th June we will honour St. Peter and St Paul. Definitely not 'ordinary' yet!

In our Gospel reading we hear from St. John and Jesus' first words are: 'God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son.' God is perfect, pure Love! This Love is relational between Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The Father is the Source of Love and he pours out his Love upon the Son who receives this Love, returns this Love back to the Father while at the same time sharing this Love with the Spirit. This happens eternally and yet God has chosen to express this Love in time and space in Creation which bears the divine stamp and reaches its summit in humanity. Because of the Fall, God wants to save the human race and that is why Jesus Christ, God's Son, is sent. This is Mystery! We can try and fathom what God is like. The love we know on earth is but a taste of the Love of heaven. The perfection of Love in Jesus Christ can only be glimpsed in our efforts to mirror his Sacrifice. When I think I have understood, I realise that there is still so much further to go!

What about ourselves and our lives on earth? God is calling us to share in his eternal life of Love - that is our destiny. We have been created in God's image and likeness - that reveals our dignity. We are worth saving which is why God was willing to send his Son - He is the Gift who transforms us. This week as you love others, consider whose Love you are showing; when you experience love, open your eyes to God's Love breaking into your life. The rest will one day be made very clear to us all!
