



Fourth Sunday of the Year 1st February 2015 (p. 132 of Mass book)

Just this Sunday and two more and then it will be Lent! It is frightening how fast time can fly. How do you regard time? What slows things down for you to an enjoyable pace? Can the days drag? Does the hectic pace of life leave you breathless? Do you experience 'buzz' when everything races by? Perhaps you are thinking that just the mention of time is an issue!

Today Jesus - in St. Mark's Gospel - starts a very busy few days in his ministry. He is teaching, healing, enjoying hospitality, journeying throughout Galilee; he is surrounded by hordes of people as well as his followers AND has time for individual, personal encounters. We are told (next week) that he goes off early in the morning to a deserted place to pray. He must have been exhausted! Jesus understands humanity...he has compassion on us! Take time today to reflect on the people who need you - your love, support, care and encouragement. Thank God for those who are signs to you of his presence. Ponder how allowing space in your life for the Lord inspires you, energises you, carries you.
