

Thirty-first Sunday of the Year 5th November 2017 p. 149 of Mass book In Parliament this week there has been a change in expectations of personal behaviour and morals. Resignations and accusations have altered the view people have of those who have the responsibility of governing us. For some time personal conduct was seen as something private and no one else's business. It seems now that times have changed and memories of bad treatment and suffering are affecting how we perceive what should be the right way. Very appropriate as we contemplate today's Gospel reading as Jesus speaks about the (religious) leaders of his day.

The scribes and the Pharisees are given a hard time again! In today's passage from St. Matthew, Jesus praises their teaching but not their putting it into practice! He has no time for titles and honours; he is not happy with the adulation they seek in public. Why does St. Matthew choose to remember these words for posterity in his Gospel? Perhaps his own community is suffering very much at the hands of the religious adherents of the Law adding many, many extra requirements which have to be followed? Maybe all they see is an empty, superficial response to God's love for his people? Could it be that St. Matthew sees in his own (Christian) community the very things that Jesus criticises and realises that this might be a problem in the future for those who follow Jesus?

It is very easy in general when confronted with a hard-hitting Gospel passage to think to oneself 'Jesus is talking about someone else...he can't have me in mind?!' For me as a priest, this passage challenges me to the core of who I am and all that I do as the Lord's servant in regard to what people call me, what I wear, where I am sat at table at events, my attitude to others, the way I am with family, friends, parishioners and strangers. It is not easy to be let off the hook! And yet truly to be the Lord's disciple I have to want to be like him; I have to admit my mistakes; I need to learn to let what I do be in harmony with what is going on inside. This is only possible with the Lord's help! Please pray for your priests. May your loving example and selflessness be an inspiration as we all build up God's Kingdom. God bless you. *Fr. Norbert*

Obviously, as with all ministries, a person is very much upfront and so reverence for - and love of - the Eucharist is paramount. NOVEMBER DEAD LIST There are sheets at the back of our churches on which you can write the names of loved ones who have died. These will be kept close to the altar and the names remembered at Masses throughout November. There is no need to give any money.

FIRST CONFESSION & FIRST COMMUNION Sessions for the parents of the children for First Confession and First Holy Communion will take place early next year. Children for Confession and Holy Communion are in Year 3 or above. At Holy Family Church the classes are weekly usually on a Wednesday afternoon after school starting in January/February - the Enrolment Meeting will be in Holy Family Church after 9.30 Mass today (5th). At Our Lady's Church the classes are on Sunday mornings before 11.30 Mass starting in January - the Enrolment Meeting will be on Tuesday 14th November at 7.45pm in Our Lady's Church.

CONFIRMATION Young people from our three churches in Year 9 and above who missed the enrolment meeting for Confirmation should contact Fr. Norbert as soon as possible. The course begins on Sunday 19th November at 7.15pm in the Parish Room of Holy Family Church.

MONTHLY ADORATION Some parishioners have offered to lead a monthly Holy Hour with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, worship music and reflections. It will take place on the second Friday of the month at Our Lady's after 7pm Mass with a 7.45pm start. There will be Benediction to conclude. The name chosen for the hour is 'Restoration'. The first Restoration Holy Hour will be on Friday 10th November. Everyone is welcome.
