‘Jesus summoned the Twelve and began to send them out in pairs...’ Thus we read at the start of our Gospel passage today from St. Mark. How would you have felt if you were one of them? What a tall order from the Lord to carry out such amazing works! Perhaps a feeling of inadequacy? Jesus expects his Twelve to trust him completely and rely on very little of their own. Would your faith have been as strong? We are now going to enter the school holiday season. Do you think of yourself as commissioned to do something in the holidays?

This year there will be three very important events in the life of the national and international Church. At the end of August, there will be the World Meeting of Families in Dublin. I plan to meet up with relations and friends who live in Dublin and so will have an opportunity to attend some of the sessions including input from our own Cardinal, Vincent Nichols. We will have prayer cards and reflection booklets for you. Please take one and pray for yourselves as individuals, as families and as community. May each day of the holidays be sanctified by this extra prayer and lead to a time of blessing in Dublin as people from all over the world gather.

In early September, the Bishops of England and Wales have called for a Eucharistic Congress which will take place in Liverpool. 12 of us from Welwyn Garden City (including Fr. Tom and myself) will join delegates from England and Wales. A strengthening of love for the Eucharist and the outreach which flows from the Mass will be hallmarks of the time spent in Liverpool. Hopefully the fruits will be felt for years to come.

Finally, in October, Pope Francis has called for a Synod of Bishops gathered in Rome to discuss Young People and Vocational Discernment. This is paramount for the Church as we respond to fewer answering the call to serve as priests. Also, young people and young adults have many questions and needs. We must find ways in our Garden City of responding to them.

So, this is the challenge of summer 2018! Pray for the World Meeting of Families, intensify your love of the Eucharist and ponder the yearnings of the young as they search for a way of heeding God’s call to them. God bless you and refresh you. *Fr. Norbert*
