Another week has flown by and Lent continues! The Second Sunday of Lent is always an encounter with Christ in his Transfiguration. The Divinity shines from his transfigured body and the Father's voice cries out: 'This is my Son, the Beloved. Listen to him.' The terrified disciples accompanying Jesus do not know what to say apart from Peter's attempt to hold onto the experience through making three tents - one for Jesus, one for Moses and one for Elijah. It is an incredible moment for Jesus as in such a powerful way his identity is revealed and felt; and for the disciples who are privileged to witness the event. They have to come back down the mountain and continue the journey to Calvary. That transfigured body will bear the terrible marks of suffering and then come to the glory of Resurrection. Do you think that the risen body of the Lord was different to the transfigured one?

On our trek through Lent, often we would rather not have to keep *plodding* along! It gets tiring and our patience is tested! Perhaps the destination of Easter Sunday is where we would rather be fast-forwarded? Jesus teaches us not only in the present to be with him in glimpses of glory, but also to walk with him to the Cross. The weight of the wooden beam, the lashes of the scourges, the piercing crown of thorns and the painful falls are challenging but draw us ever so deeply into the mystery of Divine Suffering and then Divine Glory - the two go together.

As a new week begins may God's wonderful and inspiring love revealed in Jesus support you. With love and prayers, *Fr. Norbert*
