

Today is the Fiftieth Day! There is noise, commotion, fire, languages and people in Jerusalem at Pentecost. AND the Good News of Jesus Christ is boldly proclaimed to the gathered throng by men who had initially been timid and afraid, most of whom had run away when this same Jesus went to his fate. What made the difference? St. Luke, the author of the Acts of the Apostles, (as well as of the Gospel) sums it up in a few words: 'They were all filled with the Holy Spirit...' Nothing would ever be the same again!

What does this say to us gathered as Church today for the Solemnity of Pentecost? Firstly, we need to sing to ourselves 'Happy birthday' as today marks the birthday of the Church! We then should let our celebration of Mass put us in the 'party' mood because the Church is still around, alive and active! Further still, the challenge is to allow the same Spirit to fill our lives so that we can experience the transforming grace of God which helps us overcome fear, nerves and inadequacy and truly become Church which is the living Body of Christ empowered with his Spirit on a journey to the Father.

Christ needs us to carry on his work of reconciliation: this is so evident in the Gospel passage from St. John where we return to Easter Day and discover the presence of the Risen Lord in the midst of his disciples. He breathes upon them, saying: 'Receive the Holy Spirit' and proceeds to speak about forgiveness. The hallmark of the Christian community based upon these words is going to be a readiness to offer forgiveness and to hold it back if some refuse to be open to it. Jesus sends them out in the same way he was sent by the Father. He will return to the Father and obviously wants us to follow him on this path - in God's time. So many people are unaware of the wonder of Christian Faith, of the Good News of Jesus and the ability to live out his message. May the Holy Spirit breathe new life into us and help us to put into action the Gospel. Then there'll be many more birthdays still to come!
