

Palm Sunday 2nd April

It's Holy Week! There has been a deluge of rain at so many moments of almost every day. What will it be like this week? The Church furnishes us with Liturgies varied and challenging! What difference will a downpour make?

Today we carry palms and recall the Lord's triumphal entry into Jerusalem. 'Hosanna!' is the song we cry out. On Maundy Thursday water is used to wash feet in remembrance of what Jesus did in loving service to his disciples. Bread broken and wine poured out put us in touch with Christ's loving Sacrifice. On Good Friday our focus is on the wood of the Cross which became an instrument of Jesus' death and the vehicle for his glorification. On Holy Saturday there is stillness and waiting for the Night of all Nights when we will proclaim that the Son of God who experienced death has risen to New Life. At the Easter Vigil, we will be with the Israelites keeping watch as the waters of the Red Sea part and they cross from suffering and slavery, making their way to the Promised Land. Water is poured upon the newly baptised and Sacred Chrism brings the wonderful, powerful scent of Christ to the newly initiated. Baptismal Promises are renewed and the Easter Water splashed in every direction! By this time next week, it will all have happened and there will be total exhaustion, having journeyed through so many emotions. Then the FIFTY DAYS of Easter!

Every year is slightly (or hugely) different. As we contemplate St. Matthew's Passion today, the evangelist has Jesus say 'It is at your house that I am keeping Passover with my disciples.' Let us prepare ourselves to have the Lord with us. Let us offer him our prayerful support. Let us feel the intimate love he is bringing to us and our world. Let us take the road to Calvary together and carry the Cross with him. If you are going away, let the holiness of these days make an impact on yourselves. If you are remaining here, enjoy being with the community. For those who are new or are visitors, it is a joy to welcome you!

HOLY WEEK NOTES: CHRISM MASS This Mass will be at Westminster Cathedral (near Victoria SW1P 1QJ) on Tuesday 4th. The Cardinal, Bishops and clergy of the Diocese will renew their priestly promises. The Holy Oils will be blessed: Oil of Catechumens which prepares a person for Baptism, the Oil of the Sick used to give strength to those who are seriously ill or infirm and Sacred Chrism used after the Baptism of a child, for Confirmation, Ordination and to consecrate churches and altars. There is a great sense of the Diocese coming together and everyone is welcome. If you've never been to this Mass, why not think about it?

MAUNDY THURSDAY This year at the Mass of the Lord's Supper, there will be the Washing of Feet. The Bishops' Conference has given permission for people to receive the Precious Blood from the chalice once again. However, Fr. Norbert feels that with so many worries about contamination and Covid, it is best not to reinstate Holy Communion under both kinds just yet. There will be watching at the Altars of Repose after the Mass of the Lord's Supper (until midnight) at Holy Family in the church and at Our Lady's in the Chapel. It is possible to pop in at various times during the evening. Come and spend time with the Lord in preparation for his Passion, Death and Resurrection. GOOD FRIDAY This year people will be able to approach the Cross individually in each church during the Solemn Passion. You may wish to kiss the Cross, touch it or make a gesture of reverence (for example a bow or genuflection). The altar servers will wipe the area where the Cross is touched. The Evening Service at 8pm is a time of reflection with Scripture, music and silence - a chance to reflect back over the day's events.

HOLY SATURDAY Many countries have a tradition of the Blessing of Food. At 4pm at Our Lady's, baskets with hams, bread and painted eggs will be laid at the foot of the altar and blessed. There will be hymn-singing in Polish but everyone is most welcome. This Service lasts 30 minutes. EASTER VIGIL This is the most important celebration of the year which should start after sunset - hence 8.30pm. There will be a huge fire outside Our Lady's Church. The Easter Candles for our three churches will be lit from the fire and carried into the darkened building. Scripture in abundance and then water to be blessed with the celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). This year there will be 21 adults and two children. Finally, we will have our Easter Eucharist. The Service should take around two-and-a-half hours. Afterwards we will gather in the Trinity Hall to celebrate Easter with our new members. If you've never attended the Easter Vigil, why not come this year?

LENTEN COURSE with Fr. William. Final session on Wednesday at 7.15pm in the Parish Room of Holy Family. There will be refreshments beforehand.

LENT Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament: Monday at Our Lady's 10.00 -10.30am. Enjoy the peace and quiet of prayer before the Lord in the Eucharist.

Stations of the Cross will follow 9.30 Mass at Holy Family on Wednesday.

Sacrament of Reconciliation Thursday at Holy Family 10.00 - 10.30am, Saturday at St. Bonaventure's 10.00 - 11.00am. WALSINGHAM PILGRIMAGE On Saturday 20th May, we will be going by coach to Walsingham and will join the National Pilgrimage of the Deaf. The coach will leave from Our Lady's at 8am and depart from Walsingham around 4.30pm (arriving back around 7pm). There will be Mass and we will walk the Holy Mile. Please bring a picnic lunch hopefully to be enjoyed in good weather! Then there will be time to visit the Slipper Chapel and have personal prayer. The cost is £20 per seat. Please fill in one of the forms at the back of the church and return it with your money to Fr. Norbert.

ELY The Christian Churches in WGC have arranged a day out in Ely on Saturday 10th June. Fr. Norbert who chairs the group has booked three coaches for this trip, which will give local Christians the opportunity to spend a day together. It includes our own special pilgrim service in the Cathedral, a tour of the Cathedral, and free time in Ely. We conclude our time in Ely with Evensong. The coaches will leave from outside Our Lady's at 8.15am and depart from Ely at 6.15pm.
