

First Sunday of Lent 17th February 2013 (page 153)

Nearly eight years ago Pope John Paul II was dying and our Lent was spent journeying with the Pope through his suffering to his eventual death. It was a unique period in the Church's life as Catholics united themselves with Christ in sacrificial love at Easter and watched the Holy Father's life ebb as he struggled to keep going. Now in 2013, we enter Lent with another unique situation for the Church.

With the announcement of Pope Benedict XVI's resignation, we will this Lent be watching historic events unfold in Rome as one Pope relinquishes office as another is elected with a puff of white smoke and the prayer of the Church. Where will he be from? What name will he choose? How will he exercise the Petrine ministry? Who would have thought a week ago that we would probably have a new Pope by Easter?

A great deal of prayer is needed! Firstly for Pope Benedict, that God may grant him peace in the decision he has made, and contentment as he lives out his remaining years. Secondly, we should pray for the Cardinals who will gather in conclave to elect a new Pope. God's Spirit works in amazing ways; none of us can predict the result. May the Church be enriched through the ministry of the new Pope.

Meanwhile Lent does continue! The Temptations in the desert remind us of our human condition and the sins we can fall into if we listen to the voice of evil. Jesus Christ stood firm; he knew his mission and never stopped carrying it out. Jesus' path took him to the Cross and after dying to take away our sins, his victory shone out in the glory of the Resurrection. That is our destiny. Jesus has blazed the trail. His footsteps mark out the way. His love makes up for what is lacking and his mercy brings forgiveness. May our lives be focused on him all the way to Easter and eventually to the eternal Easter of heaven.
