Third Sunday of Easter 14th April (page 265)

On this Third Sunday of Easter we are taken right to the end of St. John's Gospel. The disciples encounter the Risen Lord in a variety of ways. As you listen or read the text, can you name some of them?

Firstly, the disciples go fishing. After the Death and Resurrection of Jesus, they return to their livelihood. Is this because they want to go back to old ways? Is this based on a fear that he has abandoned them? That's something to ponder! However, what is certain is their lack of success. The word of the person on the seashore to them - and their willingness to respond - results in a huge catch. The Beloved Disciple can with confidence say: 'It is the Lord!'

Secondly, Jesus cooks breakfast for his disciples. What a wonderful image! The Master makes sure his friends have nourishment, renewing and strengthening them. Surely this points us to what Jesus Christ does for us every time we come to him at Mass - in the Eucharist?

Thirdly, there is the exchange between Peter and Jesus initiated by the Lord's questioning about Peter's love and then Peter's insistence that he does in fact love Jesus. Peter is commissioned to take care of the sheep and lambs. There are resonances with Peter's three denials of knowing Jesus and here Peter is given the opportunity to receive forgiveness.

Finally, as the passage draws to a close, Jesus predicts the martyrdom of Peter. Peter will meet Jesus when he goes where he would rather not go and when he dies upside down on a cross for Jesus, his Friend, Lord and God.

As you begin another week, think about how Jesus our Risen Lord wants to meet you: at work, at meals, in success/failure, in forgiveness, in love, in suffering. Look out for him. Be open to him. Let him inspire you.

God bless you in who you are and in all you do for him. Fr. Norbert
