## Fourth Sunday of Easter 21st April (page 269)

'The sheep that belong to me, listen to my voice; I know them and they follow me.' These are important words of Jesus given to us in this Sunday's Gospel reading from St. John. Relationship is at the heart of the passage. The bond between Jesus and his Father is paramount; they are one. The bond between the Son and the sheep is dependent on the sheep being a gift from the Father to the Son. We need to reflect on this for a moment!

Jesus is truly God. He is simply as much God as he is a human being. He has every divine attribute the Father has, just as he has every human attribute we have except for sin. The Father is the Source of Love in the Godhead and has begotten the Son; in that sense he is greater than the Son. But they are equal in every other way. The Love between the Father and Son issues forth in the Holy Spirit and is poured into our lives thus holding us together as the Lord's flock. In other words, we belong to Christ and we belong to each other through the Holy Spirit. Through this Love the stamp of God has been sealed in our hearts.

Have you ever thought of yourself as a gift to Jesus? What is it about you which makes you unique and prized by the Son? How does he call out to you and through whom? What is he asking of you? This is where our vocation comes from. Jesus, speaking intimately to us, invites us to follow him. Our willingness to listen and respond is a gift in itself and mirrors the total obedience Jesus has to God our Father. The result of the Lord's response is salvation for the human race - eternal life! What do you think Christ wants to bring about through you?

Let us pray that we will always value this deep, loving relationship with God - Father, Son and Holy Spirit - and that we will be prepared to give our all for God and for others. Let us pray for those still searching that they may find their way to Christ and his purpose for them.
