'Peace I bequeath to you, my own peace I give you.' These are some of the words from the Gospel today. St. John opens us up to Jesus' conversation with his disciples at the Last Supper and wants our hearts to resonate with the Word of God - a Word to enlighten us, feed us and direct us.

At this time there are so many wonderful sounds we can hear - especially of the birds singing outside, perhaps waking us up at dawn! This is such a great sign that the spring has come and that the New Life of Easter is affecting even creation. I can see blossom and flowers preparing me for the riot of colour which will break in over the course of the next few months. As I write, I can feel the warmth of the sun shining down upon me and hinting that summer may really be coming!

Hearing, seeing and feeling the beauty of nature brings such joy. The peace of Christ is like that. Take time to listen to the silence which will open you up to the presence of Christ. Look around you and let nature take you closer to the Author of Creation. Allow the combination of silence and beauty to penetrate you to the core of your being uniting you with the peace and glory of God revealed to us in Jesus. This is the amazing conversation between God and each one of us and elements of creation which bear the stamp of Christ!

The peace of Christ is left to us as pure gift. This peace is for us as individuals, families, households, communities, nations and the world. How our world is desperate for this kind of peace! To create the harmony which has Christ's peace at its heart requires us to discover that same peace in our hearts and to offer it to others, to let barriers of division, hatred, prejudice and fear tumble down through his Spirit. We CAN be true peacemakers and transform our world.

As you reflect on these words this week, allow Christ to speak them in you. Proclaim them in your daily lives. Be instruments of reconciling love.
