Next Tuesday Archbishop Vincent Nichols is gathering the 'Jubilarians' of the Diocese for Mass and lunch at Archbishop's House. So, I have been invited. I'll probably be one of the youngest. There will be those ordained 40, 50, 60 years and one priest, Canon Louis Thomas, will be celebrating 70 years of Priesthood! The following week, I have been invited to a Garden Party at Buckingham Palace on Wednesday 22nd May. That will be a new experience for me! With Her Majesty the Queen reducing her engagements I'm not quite sure whether or not she'll be there. Next month, there will be the Silver Jubilee Masses in Edgware and Welwyn Garden City. At the end of June, we shall celebrate with Jeffrey his Ordination to the Priesthood. Celebrations give us a chance to give thanks, to remember and to look forward; they offer people an opportunity to be together and focus on who and what really matters.
