Last Wednesday I led a retreat day for the deaf community on a barge! We set off from Harlow, got stuck in a lock, managed to get unstuck and then proceeded to have Mass as we sailed along at three miles per hour. After a stop for a picnic lunch, the skipper turned us around and we made our way back to Harlow. It was such an amazing experience. Firstly, to see the beauty of creation with the trees forming a canopy over the river in places and the swans and ducks with their young darting out of the way. I watched the deaf as they sat at the front of the boat soaking in the sun and taking delight in what they could see. We worked well together with the crew, opening/closing the locks (except the faulty one!) and filling/emptying the locks. Mass took us to the Sea of Galilee and many present commented on how they could now imagine being with Jesus in a boat on the water. God is so good. God is mighty in his works. God has blessed us with so many gifts.

In today's Gospel reading, we hear from St. Luke about the seventy-two being sent out in pairs to proclaim the Good News; their return is marked by great excitement as they acknowledge that Jesus has worked through them. As we get ready for the summer holidays to begin, let us reflect on the ways that God has worked in our lives. Perhaps things have been complicated for you and you have just about made it with God's help? Maybe you have sailed through with no worries?
