# Sixteenth Sunday of the Year 21st July 2013 (page 112) to include 28th July (page 114)

Today we journey with Jesus to the house of Martha and Mary. If you knew that Jesus was coming to visit, what would you do to prepare? Would you worry about the place being tidy? Would you wonder what he would inspect? Is it the catering which would be high up on the list of priorities? We know that Jesus is travelling towards Jerusalem with a huge crowd; he is teaching them and forming them. We are not told by St. Luke what happened to these people when the Lord stopped off at Martha and Mary's. Perhaps this is why the former was so distracted - wondering about how many she was cooking for!

The focus in the passage is on Jesus with Mary sitting at his feet listening. Martha's attempts to take over and disrupt the proceedings are comical and swept to one side by Jesus. His disciple Mary has chosen the correct attitude: she listens attentively and is caught up in the Word of God. I am sure that she makes place in her heart and soul for the message she is receiving and in time will find the opportunity to share this Good News with others. Near the beginning of St. Luke's Gospel, we enter into a powerful scene involving a different Mary. At the Annunciation Our Lady encounters the Angel Gabriel, listens attentively to the message of invitation to be Mother of God and says 'Yes!' Her listening is an active process whereby she is totally receptive to the Spirit and allows the Word to become flesh in her womb. Martha is active in a busy, bossy way! She shows great hospitality by welcoming Jesus into her home and yet she probably has no room inside herself to receive his word.

As the summer continues to seize hold of us with sunshine and heat, I'm sure we would rather be with Mary resting at the Lord's feet than with Martha in the hot kitchen! However, let us try to have that attentive ear, the receptive heart and a willingness to let the Word of God be alive in us. Have a good fortnight! God bless you. *Fr. Norbert*
