

God of abundance, all good things come from you.

The world, full of life, reflects your glory and sings your praise.

You call us all to share fairly the bounty of your creation,

and the gifts you give us.

But so many people in this world of plenty do not have enough to eat.

And so we ask you, God of all, to create in us
a desire to make all things new,

So that through your goodness all those in need may eat and be satisfied. We ask this through Christ our Lord, Amen.

This is the prayer given us by CAFOD to use on the Fast Day this Friday.

In today's Gospel from St. Luke, Jesus puts us on the spot as he challenges us with another parable. A rich man closes his eyes to the misfortune of poor Lazarus and separates himself from the wonder of God in heaven. The stark warning at the end of the passage is that we should heed the words of the prophets - and of Jesus himself - and live in the hope of heaven with our hearts open to the needs of the poor and downtrodden on our earthly journey.

It is so easy to get caught up in our own lives and only focus on what we have to do, what brings us happiness, our worries and forget that there are others less fortunate than ourselves. We have to think about those far away who experience injustice and who long even for a morsel of what we have. There are those on our doorstep who are deprived and would benefit from a share of what is ours - no matter how small that might be.

On Friday we are asked to make a sacrifice - a real sacrifice for the sake of our brothers and sisters in need. Let us be like St. Francis whose feast is that day and give with a generous, cheerful heart, knowing we can make a difference. God bless you. *Fr. Norbert*

CAFOD HARVEST FAST DAY Friday 4th October. It is a stark fact that one in eight of us will go to bed hungry tonight. CAFOD is asking you to make a place at your table to help our sisters and brothers in the world's poorest countries to get enough nutritious food to eat. CAFOD Fast Day envelopes will be given out as you leave Mass today and the money you save collected in a retiring collection next weekend. Please give as much as you can so that hunger doesn't remain a fact of life. Thank you.

There will be a meeting of the Holy Family CAFOD Group on Tuesday 1st October at 7.30pm in the parish room at Holy Family. Please do come along and join us you will be made welcome.

YEAR OF FAITH will conclude with the feast of Christ the King on Sunday 24th November. As part of our prayer and reflection, the San Damiano Cross of St. Francis has been available for households to 'host' and invite others to join them in prayer. St. Francis made such a difference to the Church of his time and subsequent centuries and so it is fitting to pray with the Cross that spoke to him, asking him to renew the Church.
