Next weekend Advent will be with us as we begin a new Liturgical Year. We will leave behind St. Luke's Gospel and embark on many passages from St. Matthew. The final Lucan excerpt we have today shows the sheer loving mercy of Jesus in his conversation with the Good Thief as they die on their respective crosses. 'Jesus, remember me when you come into your Kingdom' is answered with the hope-filled promise 'Today you will be with me in paradise.' Here we see someone filled with a new vision of Jesus and presented with the destiny of heaven; here we see the Gospel being proclaimed with ever greater intensity.
