First Sunday of Advent 1st December 2013 (page 82)

'The joy of the Gospel fills the hearts and lives of all who encounter Jesus Christ.' These are the opening words of Pope Francis' Apostolic Exhortation Evangelii Gaudium published on Tuesday. Today as we enter the Season of Advent let us stop to ponder these few words in the opening sentence.

Firstly, our Holy Father speaks about the joy of the Gospel. Good News is at the heart of our Faith - Good News proclaimed afresh to each generation willing to hear it. Jesus Christ IS the Message from God our Father to us and to the whole of humanity. What do you think is the essence of what God wants to say to us? How have you heard it personally? What keeps it alive for you? I am sure God wants us to remember that we have been created in his image and likeness. He cannot stop telling us of his deep love for us. There is nothing that he wants to stand in the way of our being embraced by him and that is why he sent us his Son Jesus Christ, the Word made Flesh.

'...fills the hearts and minds of all...' It is all very well to know this message in our minds or only to hold it in our hearts. However, the challenge is to keep pondering the Gospel, mulling it over and cherishing it. Then to start the process all over again! We need to find ways of sharing what we have learned with others so that the deep joy of what we believe radiates from our attitudes, behaviour and conviction. Advent is a time to make space for Jesus Christ, to clear a pathway for him who is bringing us so much. It is also the time to given those around us a living experience of Divine Love.

'...who encounter Jesus Christ.' Our Faith is one of encounter - meeting with God who reveals himself in the Christ Child, in the Man hanging from the Cross, in the Risen One. He WILL come again in glory at the end of time. We meet him here at Mass and in our everyday circumstances.

Let us pray that this Advent we will let these words from Pope Francis become a reality in our lives and in our world. God bless you. *Fr. Norbert*
