Since late on Thursday evening we have heard so much about the life of the late Nelson Mandela. His words and deeds, photographs and film clips, memories of those who knew him personally as well as of those influenced by him; these have touched us in so many ways. One of the major aspects about him which has made an impact on me has been the quality, depth and breadth of the forgiveness/reconciliation which he spoke about and lived. Many of the reports have commented on how his time in prison prepared him for the office of President of South Africa and formed him into a great statesman. May he rest in peace.

In our Gospel passage from St. Matthew we encounter another heavyweight - John the Baptist. His words and actions prepared the people of his day for the coming of Christ. His role was vital as a prelude to the ministry of Jesus. We know what he wore and the delicacies he ate! We read about how he baptised and the challenges he offered the religious leaders of his day. We hear his words pointing to the One who would baptise with the Holy Spirit. John needed to have his own personal time of retreat in the desert. We do not know how he spent it! How do you think he prayed? What did he hear God saying to him? How must he have felt in being called to be the one preparing/pointing and yet having to take a back seat at the arrival of Jesus? What did he experience which points to the authenticity of his message?

In this Advent week, let us consider what we should do to be formed into true disciples of Jesus Christ. Is there a special place we can go to regularly to find God? Are there ways of praying which will inspire us? Are there people with whom we should spend some time because it is the right thing to do? Let us ask God to fashion us more and more into disciples ready to welcome the Lord. Let us pray that our words and actions will point to the Lord and will spring from a relationship deepened through our journey through Advent. God bless you. *Fr. Norbert*
