

Many of you will be aware of the *Growing in Faith* (GiF) fundraising campaign which has been initiated in our Diocese by Cardinal Vincent Nichols. The campaign raises money to support parishes through a 'project', to prepare students for priesthood and support priests in retirement, and finally to reach out to those in most need in our communities through *Caritas*. Our new Cardinal has recently written to me saying that GiF is a necessity and an effort he is asking all parishes to support by active participation. So far 140 out of the 220 parishes of Westminster Diocese have undertaken this campaign; now he wants us in Welwyn Garden City to start after Easter. Consequently in the second weekend of March there will be a census to update the records of our three churches. As yet there is no central record of names and addresses of parishioners. This would help me enormously in the administration and pastoral care of our wider Catholic Community.

For a number of months there have been meetings with the chairs of the three finance committees of the three churches of WGC to ascertain what would be the most appropriate project for WGC *from a financial point of view*. The hall at Our Lady's is in dire need of work and is way beyond its intended lifespan, with running expenses rocketing. A proposal is to rebuild the hall as the Hall for the Catholic Community of Welwyn Garden City and beyond, for it to be run by a committee made up from Holy Family, St. Bonaventure's and Our Lady's and to involve all parishioners in the project i.e. its design, its building and upkeep. To upgrade the Hall would cost around £400k; a new Hall would be in the region of £700k. It makes sense to invest in a project, the legacy of which would be for over 60 years.

An architect is at present putting together drawings of what a new hall might look like and some possible features. These should be ready to put up in our three churches the week beginning 17th March. I ask you to look carefully at the drawings and 'dream'.

Nothing has been already decided. Your views are paramount. What would you like a new hall to have? What do you think the needs of our community might be in 10/20 years' time? What legacy do you want for your children, grandchildren and future generations? My hope is to have a meeting before the school holidays on Wednesday 2nd April at 7.30pm in the (present) hall. This will give an opportunity for questions to be asked, comments voiced and dreams shared. The final decision does not have to be made before Easter but a sense of where we are going is essential. I would ask that a committee be formed of those willing to work with, and carry forward, the project for the next few years. At this stage consultation, planning and a deep sense of ownership are essential. Money will have to be raised and the necessary planning permission sought. Bishop John Sherrington has assured me that the vision for Welwyn Garden City of being one parish with three churches is still what the Diocese wants for us. The Financial Secretary of the Diocese has given an undertaking that the project would be supported by the Trustees of the Diocese and that a loan for ten years would be given. It would take a year or two for the finer details to be ironed out and in due course the work would begin.

My major concern as your Parish Priest is that the project undertaken here in WGC would be worthy of you the people and that future generations would be so grateful to the parishioners of 2014 for taking this bold and decisive step. When the church in my previous parish was restored I told the people that it was not being done for me and that one day I would be moved. In fact not long after it was completed I was moved to WGC! So you are the ones ultimately who need to be committed to the project and to support it with your ideas and your contributions.

Let us respond to our Cardinal in his aspirations. Let us co-operate in our shared vision. Let us strengthen the bonds between people and our reaching out through this project.

May God bless us and guide us in the coming months. Fr. Norbert.
