

## Fourth Sunday of Lent 30th March 2014 (page 164)

In today's Gospel from St. John, we witness the encounter between a man who was born blind and Jesus. The man is not only healed by the Lord but comes to a deep faith, saying: 'Lord, I believe'. On the face of it, it seems so simple and yet there is so much hassle from various people who cannot believe - or just do not want to believe - what has taken place.

On Palm Sunday (13th April) we will see Jesus riding into Jerusalem on a donkey. On Maundy Thursday we will see the Lord washing the feet of his disciples and instituting the Eucharist. On Good Friday he will be lifted up on the Cross for our salvation. And finally on Easter Sunday with St. Peter and the Beloved Disciple we will see the Empty Tomb. What a journey awaits us in these coming weeks! Crucially it is the seeing AND believing which are paramount. Lent is a time of preparation and penance calling us to a deeper faith in Jesus Christ. In our own community there are many adults preparing for the Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil. Some will be baptised; some received into the Catholic Church; all will be confirmed and receive Holy Communion. What an outpouring of grace upon them - and upon us! Lent is also a season challenging us to see the Lord's presence in the person in need and offering support. There is still time to respond.

Today on Laetare Sunday, the pink vestments remind us to rejoice that we are half-way through the rigour of Lent. The journey continues; the end is in sight. What makes this week different for our school children is that they break up on Friday. This means that our parents will have the responsibility of encouraging their children in the final thrust towards Holy Week and the Sacred Easter Triduum. May be many will be away? Please try and find out the times of Services wherever you are going to be. If you have never in the past attended the major celebrations of the Triduum, why not do so in 2014? Let us all get ready truly to see Jesus in his Passion, Death and Resurrection, to deepen our love for him and to be strengthened in the Faith we profess.
