
WELWYN GARDEN CITY



Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion 13th April 2014 (page 184) 'It is at your house I am keeping Passover with my disciples.' These are the words Jesus wants his disciples to say to 'so-and-so' in the city. 'So- and-so' could be you or me! Jesus longs to share with each one of us his Passion, Death and Resurrection. Lent is nearly over; no matter how we have spent this season, the time has now come for the Lord's Passover to take place. He will eat and drink with us at table, offering his Body and Blood. He will be lifted up on the Cross, pouring our his life for us. He will be raised to New Life on Easter Day revealing to us his Victory over sin and death.

How will YOU keep these days? The Sacred Triduum is the holiest period of the Church's Year. Try if you can to come to the major Services: the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday, the Solemn Liturgy of the Passion on Good Friday afternoon and the climax - the Easter Vigil. There are so many unusual elements to these liturgies: the Washing of Feet on Thursday, the Adoration of the Cross on Good Friday and the Easter Fire with the Sacraments of Initiation on Holy Saturday Night. The Services are more complex than at other times of the year and do take longer. However, when you are caught up in the eternity of Death and Resurrection, time ceases to matter! In our homes let us keep a sense of watchful prayer throughout the week. Perhaps our televisions might have a bit of a rest? Perhaps the family or household might make time for shared prayer? Perhaps silence might reign in anticipation of all that will take place?

If you are going away, try and find a church and share in the prayer of another community. I am sure that here in Welwyn Garden City we will be welcoming many visitors - which is so good! There will be people who will wonder what is going on, what the 'Celebration' is all about. The challenge and the joy will be ours to share with them our faith in the Son of God who for the Salvation of the world was willing to suffer, die and rise - and no one should miss out on that!

BISHOP JOHN will be with us in Welwyn Garden City for the Easter Triduum this year. He will lead a meditation on 'The Last Words of Jesus' on Good Friday at 7.30pm in St. Bonaventure's.

CHRISM MASS at Westminster Cathedral (Victoria Street, London SW1P 1QJ) on Tuesday 15th April at 12 noon. If you have never attended this Mass it is well worth trying to go. The Cardinal will bless the Holy Oils to be used in the Diocese in the coming year: the Oil of Catechumens in preparation for Baptism, the Oil of the Sick to anoint those who are seriously ill and the Oil of Chrism for use at Baptism, Confirmation, Ordination and to consecrate churches and altars. At this Mass priests renew their Ordination Promises and usually there are around 300 present. As Dean of Stevenage, Fr. Norbert collects the Holy Oils and distributes them to the parishes of this deanery.
