Fifteenth Sunday of the Year 13th July (page 102 of the Mass book)

'Some seed fell on rich soil and produced their crop...Listen anyone who has ears.' What an amazing message from Jesus to the crowds gathered on the seashore as they listen to his teaching. Just think of the throng of people with the sun blazing down on them and the cool breeze coming from the sea. They must have wondered what he was going to say. Jesus gives them images from their own experience: the sower's concern is to ensure that some seed lands on rich soil where it will germinate and draw strength from the ground on which it falls. The sower realises some will get wasted but that does not take away from his confidence that his efforts will bear fruit.

Jesus challenges his audience to listen, to open their ears fully and be receptive to his words. As you listen, what is Jesus saying to you today? What do you consider he wants to plant in you? Do you want this to happen? Are you helping his 'seed' to take root within you and grow? What can you do to co-operate with his grace? Do you really believe that this rich soil is in you? As the summer continues to unfold, we will see the crops growing and in no time the fields will be ready for harvesting. Look, watch, think and allow this parable of Jesus to resonate deep within you. Take heart from what Jesus has to say!

Soon many of you will be away on holiday. As happens throughout the year we will welcome a huge number of visitors to our community. I pray that the holidays will give everyone an opportunity for refreshment, peace and relaxation. I ask God's blessing on those who come to join us for Mass and worship in our churches; may they experience a warmth of welcome that makes a difference to their stay in the Garden City. Whether we are on holiday or not, the seed continues to grow - if we let it!
