Forgiveness, peace, glory and triumph are some of the words which issue as we unravel the mystery of the Cross.

Do we love the world which God has loved so much? Would we be willing to make the ultimate sacrifice for this world as Jesus Christ did? The wood of the Cross is part of God's Creation, taking us back to Genesis and the Tree in the Garden that was the cause of humanity's downfall. The wood now is a throne carrying the Son of God and lifting him up in exaltation. Jesus hallows the wood so that it becomes humanity's weapon in defeating sin and death. God's love is personal and so deep and yet it extends to every corner of the earth and to every generation. This love pours forth from the Cross and brings life in abundance.

Today's feast takes precedence over the 24th Sunday of the Year. We would have had a parable from St. Matthew about the Unforgiving Servant who refuses to cancel a small debt when his master has forgiven him a huge fortune. Jesus wants us to forgive from the heart and as many times as is necessary. Surely the Cross is the constant reminder that God is ready to forgive us unceasingly? As we glory in the Cross of Our Lord Jesus Christ, let us allows its power to work in us in ways we never thought possible!
