Twenty-eighth Sunday of the Year 12th October (p.140 of Mass book)

'There is nothing I cannot master with the help of the One who gives me strength.' These are some of St. Paul's words from his Letter to the people of Philippi. In some ways they sound like the Angel Gabriel's words to Our Lady in St. Luke's Gospel at the Annunciation when he says: 'Nothing is impossible to God.'

As you come to Mass today, what is it that weighs on your mind? What is it that you have tried to sort out or achieve which seems to have eluded you? Where have you found a lack of success which has led you to despair? What obstacles have been put in your way? The Apostle knew he could trust God and that whatever might have been the case in the past, all things were still possible. Paul really believed! Do you? Do we? Paul was seeking a strength from God to give him courage for all that he faced and to be able to handle the issues of his ministry. What do you need from God at this time?

Our Lady was ready to receive God's answer in his way. She trusted and she was open. Mary said 'Yes' and lived out that commitment all through her Son's life and especially when it took him to the Cross. How must she have felt as she watched him give his life for our salvation? We can imagine her heart was broken. Did she really understand? Perhaps she thought back to Simeon's words that a sword would pierce her heart? Did she give up? There is such nobility in the fact that she remained standing at the foot of the Cross right to the end.

Paul ends by speaking of the community sharing with him in his hardships. We need one another's help and support. We cannot manage except with the mutual love and care which are hallmarks of our Christian life. Together with St. Paul we can say: 'Glory to God our Father forever and ever. Amen!'
