

HOLY FAMILY

Twenty-ninth Sunday of the Year 19th October (p.143 of Mass book)

"Give back to Caesar what belongs to Caesar - and to God what belongs to God." These memorable words of Jesus come as a result of a plot between the Pharisees and Herodians to catch Jesus out. The religious elite comes together with those who support Herod, Rome's puppet king - what a combination! As always Jesus is in the driving seat, asking for a coin and demanding to know whose head is on it. Perhaps this implies that Jesus himself carried no money...a sign of poverty? (or royalty in our own day!) Jesus then asks his antagonists whose head and name are on the coin; the response of "Caesar's" leads to Jesus' saying quoted above.

Many people assume that Jesus is teaching us to keep religion out of politics, that the sacred and the everyday are separate or even that there are some things in life only for God and others which are of the world. What do YOU think? Is there anything in your life that you feel does not belong to God? Maybe put another way: Is there an aspect of your life which you think God is not bothered about? Do you really believe that you are created in God's image and likeness as we read in Scripture? If so, then everything about you speaks of God - both in him communicating himself to you and in you communicating him to others. At the Easter Vigil, as the Paschal Candle is being prepared, the priest says: "Christ yesterday and today, the Beginning and the End, the Alpha and the Omega. *All time belongs to him* and all the ages. To him be glory and power through every age and for ever. Amen." On such a solemn night and at the highpoint of all that we believe in, there is such a profound affirmation of what is God's!

Next year on 7th May, we will be given the opportunity to vote in a General Election. There will be so much to think about and reflect on. I am sure you will receive a huge amount of literature through your letter box and have many callers at your front door canvassing. Our Bishops will give us pointers too based on our faith. Take time at this stage to consider what really matters. Start asking yourself the difficult questions which you in turn might put to the candidates! Pray that God's Spirit will guide you. Remember the wider community and the whole world which will be affected by where you put your cross. We can and should make a difference. We must keep God at the heart of our own personal picture and allow him to underpin all that takes place. Let us invite Jesus to be in the driving seat! God bless you. *Fr. Norbert*

WORLD MISSION SUNDAY is celebrated in every parish throughout the world and reminds us that we are all called to mission no matter who we are or where we live.
