

Feast of Christ the King 23rd November (p.158 of Mass book)

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. What a title! Who is he? Where do we find such a king? What is he like? Firstly, Jesus is the Son of God. He is the Father's Anointed One - the Christ. He is truly a human being except for sin. He is the embodiment of Love. In regard to my second question, the strange thing about today's Gospel reading from St. Matthew is that we do not find him in the usual places where we would normally encounter royalty: he is in a person in need; he feels our love as we support him; he understands rejection because there are so many destitute people who are still searching for someone to reach out to them. Finally, as we read from the Prophet Ezekiel, he is like - indeed, he IS - a Shepherd who looks out for his sheep, taking good care of the weak and fragile as well as the strong and healthy. Jesus Christ is the Shepherd who has laid down his life for his sheep by being lifted up on the Cross in his Suffering, Death and Resurrection. Our Lord is a King who knows us through and through AND LOVES US! On this special day, the last Sunday of the Church's Year, let us pray that we will do what we can to get to know him better and love him with all our hearts. This will inevitably mean looking out for the suffering and trying to understand why he identifies with them!

This weekend I have set off for Goa (India) where my family originally comes from. The Exposition of the body of St. Francis Xavier gives many the opportunity to remember this great Saint who took the Christian Faith to the East and gave his life in the service of the Gospel. When I went ten years ago, I was struck by the sheer numbers of people, Christian, Hindu and Muslim, who flocked to see the relics and to gather in prayer. You will be in my prayers. May God bless you and strengthen you as you follow Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. *Fr. Norbert*
