
## WELWYN GARDEN CITY

In Jesus, God became one like us, but did not cease to be God at the same time. Let us continue to reflect and pray about that great event that happened in Bethlehem all those years ago. The message is true; life giving and the beginning of our salvation and the consequences of that night are as relevant to the world today as they were then.
