

HOLY FAMILY

Second Sunday of the Year 18th January 2015 (p. 127 of Mass book)

Today we enter the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. Our Garden City was founded on Christian principles and the strength of the Christian Faith continues to play a vital part in our town. The Churches work together in projects like SPACE, in Christians Against Poverty (to support those burdened by debt) and especially through the Food Bank. Ministers and Church Leaders meet regularly. This Week of Prayer gives an opportunity to celebrate God's Spirit at work in our midst and to pray hard that the same Spirit will help us find ways of coming closer together in a harmony that proclaims Jesus Christ even better and more clearly to those around us. In the coming days there are lunchtime services in various churches in different districts of our town. On Saturday evening there will be a shared supper at Focolare and then the Week culminates in next Sunday's Joint Service at Herts International Church at which Bishop John Sherrington will give the address. Come to what you can and pray hard for the unity of all Christians.

Today is Peace Sunday in this country. The Pope's message takes as its theme: 'No longer slaves but brothers and sisters'. Pope Francis describes slavery as 'an open wound on the body of the human family – a running sore on the flesh of Christ'. Someone is considered to be in slavery if they are forced to work - through mental or physical threat; owned or controlled by an 'employer', usually through mental or physical abuse or the threat of abuse; dehumanised, treated as a commodity or bought and sold as 'property'; physically constrained, or with restrictions placed on his/her freedom of movement. The Pope says: 'The Church is charged with showing to all the path to conversion, which enables us to change the way we see our neighbours, to recognize in every other person a brother or sister in our human family, and to acknowledge his or her intrinsic dignity in truth and freedom. This can be clearly seen from the story of Josephine Bakhita, the saint originally from the Darfur region in Sudan who was kidnapped by slave-traffickers and sold to brutal masters when she was nine years old. Subsequently – as a result of painful experiences – she became a "free daughter of God" thanks to her faith, lived in religious consecration and in service to others, especially the most lowly and helpless. This saint, who lived at the turn of the twentieth century, is even today an exemplary witness of hope for the many victims of slavery; she can support the efforts of all those committed to fighting against this "open wound on the body of contemporary society, a scourge upon the body of Christ".'

There is much to pray for today. There is lots we can do in practical ways to make a difference. Let us try hard! God bless you. *Fr. Norbert*
