
## WELWYN GARDEN CITY



'And at once they left their nets and followed him.' These are the words used by St. Mark to describe what happened on the shore of Galilee when Jesus called Simon and his brother Andrew. Amazing! We take for granted that these brothers (and James and John too) just got on with it; their response was immediate and that was that! There are two aspects of this account on which I would like to focus and ask you to reflect on.

Firstly, Simon and Andrew were in their boat fishing - they were casting their net in the lake - so they would have been a distance from land. Jesus saw them and they must have let his gaze touch them to the core of their being. They heard his voice and it must have resonated within them as they left everything to follow the Lord. Did they have time to get the boat back to land? Did they have to jump into the water to chase after the Jesus? What would those around them have made of this strange sight? James and John must have been affected by the event. How do you let Jesus see you in the every day? What does he see in you? What does his voice sound like? And, importantly, are there things he wants you to let go of and leave behind? Could your example have an even greater impact on someone else?

Secondly, they followed Jesus. Later on in St. Mark's Gospel, when Jesus chooses the Twelve, we are told that they are the ones he wanted and they were to be his companions. That means they spent time with him sharing meals, conversation, walking on the road and witnessing so much. They sensed that they were special to him and that that entailed being with him. You too have been chosen by the Lord! How can you make yourself his companion? How can you get to know him better and understand his ways? What is the challenge of being identified with him?

Let us pray today that Jesus will help us to hear him, see him and love him with all our hearts! God bless you. *Fr. Norbert*
