
## WELWYN GARDEN CITY



We have now entered the 'season' of First Confessions: yesterday the children (and parents) of Holy Family, next week St. Bonaventure's and then the following week Our Lady's. I have had meetings with parents to reflect on the power and beauty of this Sacrament. We pondered what forgiveness really means and how hard it can be to mean it when offering forgiveness. Last Wednesday we spent time in the 'open Confessional' of Our Lady's! Is it easier or better to behind the grille? What might be the advantages of being 'face to face' with the priest? I tried to share with parents the huge challenge a priest faces when hearing Confessions: how to respond to the penitent; the listening ear which is so crucial; the ability to allow the Confession to be an encounter with Jesus Christ; not judging the person confessing their sins and yet being a source of inspiration and challenge. The whole notion of 'The Seal of Confession' many parents found intriguing - the fact that a priest promises not to let anyone else know the content of a Confession and the complicated situations and sins a priest might have to take on his shoulders. The 'Seal' should give the penitent the confidence to speak honestly.

A key question is '*Why* do we have to confess our sins when God is always ready to forgive us if we turn to him with a repentant heart?' Perhaps this is something which bugs you who are reading this piece? A Sacrament always has a tangible, concrete aspect. In the Sacrament of Reconciliation we have the opportunity to find words to *express* what we know we have done which is wrong, namely things which have offended God and/or hurt others. We then *hear* that we are forgiven. We do not guess or assume anything. In the Lord's name the priest tells us that we are forgiven as we hear the words of Absolution. Obviously, speaking about deep, personal and perhaps painful things in our lives can be very difficult, but the liberation, peace and joy experienced are beyond compare. This is what God wants us to have a share of in this wonderful way. The light of the transfigured Christ bursts into our lives and makes such a difference. At this early stage of Lent why not set yourself to go to Confession? Don't worry. Trust in the Lord and trust in his priest! God bless you. *Fr. Norbert*
