

Fr. Norbert writes: A couple from WGC attended a Retrouvaille weekend and subsequent meetings and have found it beneficial in coming through Marriage difficulties. They wanted to speak at each Mass one Sunday, but I thought it better for them to write a piece for the newsletter so that everyone might have a chance to read more either for themselves or for a couple they know. Retrouvaille - help to save marriages.

The word Retrouvaille is a French word meaning rediscovery. The program offers tools needed to rediscover a loving marriage relationship. Thousands of couples in cold, unloving relationships or even divorced have successfully overcome their marriage problems by attending the program. The Retrouvaille Program consists of a weekend experience combined with a series of post-weekend sessions over 3 months. It provides the tools to help put your marriage in order again. The main emphasis of the program is on communication in marriage between husband and wife.

It is not a retreat, it is not marriage counselling, or a sensitivity group. There are neither group sharing or group discussions on the weekend. It is not a time for hurting; it is a time for healing. It is for couples with marital problems including couples struggling to get along, couples considering marriage separation and couples already separated or divorced that want marriage help.

During the weekend a team of three couples and a priest (all volunteers) give a series of presentations. The team presents a technique of communication that enables you to take a good look at most areas of your relationship. The team does not provide marriage advice but practical tools to improve your marriage. They share how they were able to benefit from these techniques themselves. The weekend is not a 'miracle cure'; and the post-weekend phase is as crucial, and critical, to the healing of marriage

problems. During the post-weekend sessions, the technique learned on the weekend is further developed and is used to explore additional areas of the marriage relationship.

This year the program in England is on in Hatfield 20th – 22nd March, 18th – 20th September and also in Exeter 12th – 14th of June. Beginning Friday evening, and closing with Mass or devotional service late Sunday afternoon. The post-weekend sessions are carried out in the following months.

Retrouvaille is Catholic in origin. Couples of all faiths and those with no faith tradition are welcome to attend. No attempt is made to convert anyone to a religion. The ultimate goal of Retrouvaille is solely to help save marriages.
