It is a duty which springs from the privilege of living in a democratic society. In deciding how we vote, the question for each of us is then: How, in the light of the Gospel, can my vote best serve the common good?'

The Bishops urge us to pray before casting our vote: Lord, grant us wisdom that we may walk with integrity, guarding the path of justice and knowing the protection of your loving care for all.

May God's Spirit guide us in the choices we make. May we work hard to build up his Kingdom so that on earth we may have a taste of heaven.
