
WELWYN GARDEN CITY



Sixteenth Sunday of the Year 19th July 2015 (p. 109 of Mass book)

Last week Jesus sent out the Twelve in pairs to carry out his ministry. St. Mark relates how the Lord worked through them and today's passage speaks of their return. Firstly, Jesus gives them an opportunity to tell him about what has happened; he is a Master who cares about his followers. Then the Lord realises that they need to rest and be refreshed by spending time together, by eating some food and by moving to the intimacy of a quiet place. However, the people are several steps ahead of them and beat Jesus and his disciples to the place of sanctuary! We then see Jesus' priority - the people. It seems so unfair that the moment the disciples think they have arrived in a place of solitude, they have to give way to the people who have a different kind of hunger, namely to hear the Word of God. Nothing and no-one will prevent Jesus from this crucial work.

As you come to Mass today, what do you want to tell the Lord about? What has been a joy you have experienced this week? What have you done which has enriched the life of another person? What were the challenges you faced? Have they been resolved? Have you fallen out with someone and need to experience reconciliation? Our weekly celebration of the Eucharist gives us a place and time to be with Jesus in an oasis of love, compassion and faith. Jesus refreshes us with the power of his presence and nourishes us with his Word and with his Body and Blood. Each one of us matters so much to him that he died on the Cross for our salvation and rose from the dead so that we might have life in its fullness. This Divine Love at the heart of the Eucharist draws us more deeply into the life of Heaven as the Son offers himself to the Father in the power of the Holy Spirit. Allow him to work in your life!

With the summer months upon us, many of you will be going on holiday. Have a wonderful time and come back relaxed and renewed. For those of us still around in the Garden City, may it be a refreshing period. God bless you. *Fr. Norbert*
