

Seventeenth Sunday of the Year 26th July 2015 (p. 112 of Mass book)

Today we move to St. John's Gospel as we embark on Chapter 6. There will be a break for the Assumption (on 16th); otherwise we will follow the whole chapter before returning back to St. Mark's Gospel. Jesus works a great sign as he feeds the people close to the Sea of Galilee. Next week he is walking on the water while there is a storm at sea and then his teaching on the Bread of Life unfolds. These are very important Scripture readings which help to deepen our understanding of who the Lord is and how he strengthens us as his followers.

Today we say 'Farewell' to Fr. Gerard as he gets ready to take his holiday and then move to Westminster Cathedral. As mentioned at his leaving party, when a priest moves he leaves behind part of himself and he takes with him something of the place which he has left. We wish him every blessing in his new ministry. The theme of this year's Day points us forward to the Assisted Suicide (Assisted Dying) Bill sponsored by Rob Marris MP scheduled for debate in the House of Commons on 11th September. We are urged to contact our MP to voice our concerns about the proposed Bill. The Bishops' Conference website catholicnews.org.uk/assisted-dying-bill-2015 provides some practical steps.
