
WELWYN GARDEN CITY



Twenty-seventh Sunday of the Year 4th October 2015 (p.141 of Mass book)

As we come together for Mass this weekend, there is much to think about and pray for. In Rome the Synod on the Family begins. Pope Francis has gathered so many from all over the world to help reflect on family life in the light of the Teaching of Christ and the reality of people's situations, with their joys and sorrows, their hopes and challenges. Pope Francis wants the Church to pray that God's Spirit may guide all who attend the Synod. The Holy Father has implored those coming to contribute to the discussions from their own experience AND to listen hard to what others have to say. As Church, we then have to trust that God is guiding us and empowering the Pope to be a source of unity and the instrument or voice which articulates the Church's Teaching. As families, households and individuals, let us join in deep intercession for the Synod.

Today's Gospel passage is so challenging as we hear Jesus' very clear teaching on Marriage. Marriage is part of God's plan. It is a source of grace and blessing and can enrich a couple with joy and contentment. We all know that there are times of strain, suffering, misunderstanding; sacrifice is needed too. As we listen to the Lord, let us remember the power of his Word. Let support Marriage and pray for those preparing to enter Matrimony. Let us also not forget couples going through difficult times or who are struggling to stay together. Let us pray for those whose relationships have broken irreparably and who carry the burden of the past. Let us pray for healing, peace and fulfilment. The Gospel today also speaks of Jesus' love for children and his willingness and desire to welcome them and bless them. Their dependence on others and their openness to love offer us the vision of how to receive God's Kingdom.

Last week I mentioned I would write to Welwyn Hatfield Council about the situation of migrants and the possibility of welcoming them here in our area. The motion was passed and a new stage entered. The County Council must also be approached. Some of you at the weekend shared with me your thoughts and experiences and these were reflected in my email to the Council. Thank you.
