

**HOLY FAMILY**

Twenty-eighth Sunday of the Year 11th October 2015 (p.143 of Mass book)

'Good Master, what must I do to inherit eternal life?' This is the question put to Jesus by the man who kneels before him. Jesus speaks of the commandments and the man can honestly say he has kept them. Jesus looks steadily at him and loves him. How absolutely amazing! Then the challenge is laid before him *to go, to sell* everything he owns, *to give* the money to the poor and *to follow* the Lord. Sadness - deep sadness - sets in and he leaves Jesus' company.

Do you want to inherit eternal life? Is it easy to keep the commandments? What more does the Lord ask of you? Can you respond? These are the million-dollar questions which we, as followers of Jesus, have to ask ourselves every day. Are there things which weigh us down and prevent us from keeping our gaze fixed on the Lord? As we allow the Lord to look at us with love, are we afraid of where that will take us, in terms of the demands of the Gospel? The man was given an opportunity beyond measure to experience Life by following Jesus and he walked away. What about you? Are there times you can think back to in your own life when you let a key moment pass by and now regret not having seized it? Of course, the Lord is so patient and gives even more chances! But how many opportunities are we going to ignore before we stop and respond? What happened to that rich man after today's passage? Ponder that this week.

Turning to the Year of Mercy, the Cardinal asked each deanery to come up with a plan of what it intends to do; he wanted the outline sent to him by the end of September. The priests of Stevenage Deanery met, approved a draft plan and asked that Our Lady's Church be the one designated for the Deanery as having a Holy Door of Mercy as Our Lady's is the largest church. The Cardinal wrote to me just before he went to Rome for the Synod on the Family, formally requesting that this be the case. So we have to work on a 'Way of Mercy' in the church; there must also be a Mission of Mercy. There will be many graces coming to us all in our three parishes in Welwyn Garden City! Please pray hard as plans unfold and opportunities come our way.

**FUTURE PRIEST'S REFERENCES** The Bishops of England and Wales have had to respond to challenges against the way a Priest's Reference is given and have accordingly decided on a Certificate of Catholicity. This will come into operation for Reception and Nursery Admissions in January and March respectively. Basically a priest can only give a family a Certificate of Catholicity if the family attends Mass every week. So the responsibility is on each family to do all they can to live up to what has always been the Catholic Church's expectation that Catholics attend Mass every week. This Certificate of Catholicity will also be used for Secondary School transfer this time next year.

RCIA The Rite of the Christian Initiation of Adults started last Monday with 8 adults attending. There is still time for many more! If you are thinking about joining the Catholic Church or want as an adult to be confirmed, come to Our Lady's sacristy at 7.30pm on Monday entering from the car park.
