

Twenty-ninth Sunday of the Year 18th October 2015 (p.146 of Mass book)

Were you there when they crucified my Lord? Were you there when they crucified my Lord? Oh, sometimes it causes me to tremble, tremble, tremble. Were you there when they crucified my Lord?

This traditional spiritual hymn asks us 'Were you there?' In one sense we were not there and yet in another and much deeper way we were! When Jesus was crucified he did it out of love for us, revealing himself as a servant, a slave, who gave his life as ransom for many. This loving mercy reaches out from the Cross to each one of us and to the whole of creation; in this way we are put in touch with the riches of his grace. Surely this is awe-inspiring and should make us tremble?

In today's Gospel reading from St. Mark, Jesus has just spoken for the third time about his Passion, Death and Resurrection. The brothers James and John demand the best seats in heaven! He asks them 'Can you drink the cup I must drink or be baptised with the baptism with which I must be baptised?' And they answer 'We can.' It is amazing that they seek their preferment. The other disciples are not happy! Jesus then outlines the quality of the love which will be poured out.

To be a true disciple of Jesus means following him every step of the way, staying with him no matter what, and suffering with him as he gives his life for many. To reach his glory, we must carry the cross. This was something all the disciples needed to learn and the lesson is still there for us. Of course, at the Crucifixion we are told about the disciples running away - fear and a lack of courage get in the way. However, the Lord does not give up on them and in due course they do share in his suffering.

Let us pray that this week we will allow the Lord's love to overwhelm us to such a degree that we make sacrifices for others, give him our time and reflect through our words and actions his presence in us who count ourselves his disciples. When we find ourselves falling away or overcome by fear, let us remember the power of his Cross and make a fresh start with his help.

FUTURE PRIEST'S REFERENCES The Bishops of England and Wales have had to respond to challenges against the way a Priest's Reference is given and have accordingly decided on a Certificate of Catholicity. This will come into operation for Reception and Nursery Admissions in January and March respectively. Basically a priest can only give a family a Certificate of Catholicity if the family attends Mass every week. So the responsibility is on each family to do all they can to live up to what has always been the Catholic Church's expectation that Catholics attend Mass every week. This Certificate of Catholicity will also be used for Secondary School transfer this time next year.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION & FIRST CONFESSION 2016 Our Lady's parents will have their enrolment meeting on Tuesday 3rd November at 7.45pm in the church. Preparation will begin in January and takes place on a Sunday morning. Holy Family's parents will have their enrolment meeting on Sunday 6th December after the 9.30 Mass. Preparation will begin in January and usually takes place midweek after school . Children for First Holy Communion and First Confession should be at least in Year 3 at school. Parents' sessions start in January.
