HOLY FAMILY

Thirty-second Sunday of the year 8th November 2015 (p.155 of Mass book)

In today's Gospel reading from St. Mark, we hear Jesus speaking about two different kinds of people: firstly, the scribes with their flowing robes and the rich who contribute to the Temple funds and, secondly, a poor widow who gives everything she has in the form of two small coins equivalent to a penny. What a contrast! About the former group, Jesus says: 'Beware!'; of the widow, the Lord notes that she has given everything. Jesus observes all that takes place and can see into people's hearts. He knows the others have given a great deal but he is inspired by the total trust and pure love of the humble widow.

The sacrifice of the widow is a perfect example to hold before ourselves today as we gather for Mass. Her giving points us to the perfect Sacrifice of Jesus on the Cross and his entrusting everything into the Father's hands for our salvation. This is at the heart of the Eucharist. As Jesus saw the woman's sacrificial offering, he would have reflected on what would be asked of him when seized in the Garden of Gethsemane. This passage comes shortly before the Passion of Christ. Jesus was able to recognise his Spirit at work in the poor widow. Perhaps we might consider ourselves and how we let the Lord's Spirit into our lives inspiring us to give totally of ourselves for others and for God.

Today on Remembrance Sunday we recall the huge sacrifice of so many who gave their lives for their country, for peace, justice and freedom. The years have rolled by since the First and Second World Wars. There have been so many other wars where sacrifice was necessary to protect the vulnerable and weak. We give thanks for the service offered. However, in doing so, we never want to lose sight of our desire for peace. We need to pray for the war dead that their souls may find rest. We should pray for all who still bear the scars of war and feel the pain of their loss. May the poor widow continue to be a model of how to live filled with the presence of Christ.
