

HOLY FAMILY

Second Sunday of Advent 6th December 2015 (p.84 of Mass book)

John the Baptist appears! His life and ministry are so significant that St. Luke tells us the names of political and religious leaders at that time. St. Luke quotes from the prophecy of Isaiah and alerts us to the fact that John is the 'voice crying in the wilderness'. John's role is to PREPARE us for the coming of Christ; John challenges the people of his time and does the same for us in our day! He is determined that we should change to such a degree that we can let Christ into our lives and not miss him when he comes.

This Advent includes the start of the Year of Mercy on Tuesday. It is a privileged moment for us in Welwyn Garden City as one of our churches will have 'Doors of Mercy' to remind all who enter through them of the call to experience the Mercy of God revealed in Jesus and, in turn, to offer the selfsame loving Mercy to those we encounter. Pope Francis keeps saying that Jesus is the Face of the Father's Mercy! So to see the Lord means to encounter the One who sent him. As Christians our faces should radiate Jesus' loving Mercy which springs from our bond with him in Baptism, empowered by the Holy Spirit in Confirmation, nourished in Holy Communion. As we go out through the doors of the church, others should see in our faces the Face of Christ!

I would ask you, if you are able in this busy period, to come to Our Lady's Church on Tuesday evening at 7pm to join with me in entering the Doors of Mercy as we solemnly begin the Jubilee Year of Mercy. We will start by candlelight outside and enter in procession. We will celebrate the Mass of the Immaculate Conception of Our Lady, honouring Mary who was conceived without Original Sin and is Mother of Mercy. There will be time afterwards in the hall to gather and celebrate.

Pope Francis also asks each one of us to avail of the opportunity to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation, that is go to Confession. There are the scheduled times in each of our churches but the Advent Service of Reconciliation at 8pm on Tuesday 15th December in Our Lady's gives us a chance as a community to be together and reflect on God's Word before celebrating individual Confessions. There will be four extra priests to help that evening! Why not see it as part of your Christmas preparation? Parents bring your children! Mercy must then flow out to our relationships with others, to meeting the needs of those less well off than ourselves and trying to heal the pain and hurt of the past and present. It is never easy and much courage is crucial but God is wonderful and let us trust in his Mercy! God bless you. *Fr. Norbert*

ADVENT PRAYER There will be half an hour of Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament in Advent: on Monday after Our Lady's 9.30am Mass, on Thursday after Holy Family's 9.30am Mass and on Friday after St. Bonaventure's 9.30am Mass. Come for some quiet prayer and reflection.
