


HOLY FAMILY

Third Sunday of Advent 13th December 2015 (p.87 of Mass book)

Last Tuesday Pope Francis opened the Holy Door of St. Peter's in Rome and inaugurated the Year of Mercy. So we have begun! Here in our town on Tuesday evening we marked the beginning of the Jubilee Year with the opening of Doors of Mercy in Our Lady's Church. It was an amazing experience especially because so many people came from the other parishes of Stevenage Deanery. Our Deanery comprises of Royston, Baldock, Letchworth, Hitchin, Stevenage, Knebworth, Hatfield and Welwyn Garden City. So many representatives gathered with lighted candles outside the church in order solemnly to process into church. The Lord has a sense of humour and sent a blast of wind to blow out the candles in one big *whoosh!* Our RCIA Group was there and the Liturgy was supported in a huge number of ways by the Confirmation Group. Our young people were great ambassadors and made us feel so proud. Together with the musicians, singers, servers and hospitality group, they gave all our visitors a brilliant experience of the Church in WGC with warmth of welcome and hospitality as well as the holiness of the Mass proclaiming God's Presence and taking us to heaven. I am so grateful to everyone who worked so hard behind the scenes to get things ready and assist in all that unfolded. Our visitors kept saying 'Thank you!'

Today the Church says to us 'Gaudete! Rejoice!' There is not long to go until Christmas! John the Baptist in our Gospel passage is asked by the people who come to him 'What must we do?' This is a significant question we must ask ourselves with just a short period left of our Advent journey. Take time to stop and reflect. Pray hard for the courage to be like the Baptist and announce the Good News. Share with your loved ones an experience of a deep faith put into action as you reach out to those who are in need far away as well as those closer to home. Let us ensure that Pope Francis' vision for the Year of Mercy will be realised through our willingness to receive from God mercy beyond measure and in turn lavish it on others in a way we had never thought possible. On Sunday 27th Dcember he will celebrate the 9.30am Mass on the Feast of the Holy Family at Holy Family Church and on Friday 1st January he will celebrate the 10am Mass at Our Lady's for New Year's Day. This will be his last Christmas with us in the Garden City and we wish him every blessing as he prepares to take up the reins of North London!

RCIA There are 9 adults preparing for the Sacraments at Easter next year. The final session before Christmas is tomorrow (Monday 14th) at 7.30pm and then Monday 18th January at 7.30pm in Our Lady's sacristy. Please keep them in your prayers.
