
## WELWYN GARDEN CITY



**Fifth Sunday of the Year 7th February 2016** (page 136 of Mass book) What an amazing account we have in today's Gospel passage! People want to hear the Word of God and there are so many that Jesus has to get in a boat and speak to the people on the shore from the sea. Peter is asked to cast his net for a catch and the result is way beyond anything he expects. Peter acknowledges that he is a sinner and feel he cannot be close to Jesus. The Lord has other plans! It is now people Peter will catch rather than fish. This encounter between Christ and Peter (and his companions) changes his life for ever - AND OURS!

We are about to embark on the Season of Lent. What will help us to encounter Jesus? (More prayer, coming to an extra Mass, Stations of the Cross, quiet time at home or in church?) Where will his Word fit into our lives to nourish, stimulate and challenge us? (Listening more attentively to the Scriptures at Mass and thinking about them later on in the week, picking up a Bible to read and reflect?) Are we ready to heed the Lord's voice and do what he asks? (Reaching out to the poor and needy, making a fresh start even if we did not succeed before?) Will we acknowledge our sinfulness and seek his mercy? (Determining to make this Year of Mercy have a deeper significance by determining to go to Confession, to make up with someone we have fallen out with, to work at overcoming bad habits we've fallen into?) What does he want us to do in these 40 Days? (Learn to make sacrifices and say 'No' so that we can be like Jesus, look at our crucifixes and ponder the love poured out?) Allow today's Gospel reading from St. Luke to be a snapshot of our aspirations this Lent.

Finally, a reminder about the Plenary Indulgence attached to going through the Jubilee Doors of Mercy (at Our Lady's and elsewhere). This is an extra grace which comes from recitation of the Creed, Prayers for the Pope's Intentions (Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory Be), Reception of Holy Communion and going to Confession one week before or after a visit. Pope Francis says: 'Despite being forgiven, the conflicting consequences of sin remain ... sin leaves a negative effect on the way we think and act. But the Mercy of God is stronger even than this. It becomes indulgence on the part of the Father who, through the Bride of Christ, his Church, reaches the pardoned sinner and frees him or her from every residue of sin, enabling that person to act with charity, to grow in love rather than to fall back into sin.' Remember this is not a mechanical act, it is an invitation to change and share with others the mercy experienced in encountering God. Also, the Plenary Indulgence can be applied to the Holy Souls in Purgatory or to a sick or infirm person who cannot get to church. What a great gift we can offer to others! **ASH WEDNESDAY** is this week on 10th February. There will be 9.30am Mass at Holy Family Church, 12 noon Mass at St. Bonaventure's and 7pm Mass at Our Lady's which will be celebrated by Bishop Paul. Ashes will be blessed and distributed at these Masses as well as in The Holy Family(10.45, 11.15, 1.15) and Our Lady(9, 9.45) Schools at special services to which parishioers are welcome. Ash Wednesday is a Day of Fasting and Abstinence which means that those over the age of 14 are asked to abstain from meat and those over 16 are asked to go without a meal. The sick, elderly, pregnant and frail are not bound by these requirements.

**LENT** There will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament for 30 minutes on Mondays at Our Lady's after 9.30 Mass, at Holy Family on Thursdays after 9.30 Mass (during Confessions) and at St. Bonaventure's on Saturdays after 10am Mass (during Confessions). The Stations of the Cross will be at Holy Family on Wednesdays after 9.30 Mass, at St. Bonaventure's on Fridays after 9.30 Mass and at Our Lady's on Fridays after 7pm Mass. The next early Mass will be on Friday 4th March at 6.30am at St. Bonaventure's. The Lenten Reconciliation Service will be on Tuesday 22nd March at 8pm at Our Lady's.
