

First Sunday of Lent 14th February 2016 (page 153 of Mass book)

TEMPTATION! To eat chocolates? To cheat? To do something which won't hurt anyone else? The list is endless. Jesus is led by the Spirit out into the wilderness for a time of testing - temptation. The period is forty days and three particular temptations are mentioned.

Firstly, to turn stones into bread. Wouldn't that be wonderful - the end of hunger as we know it! Jesus must have felt the pangs of hunger in the midst of the desert heat. In the wilderness he would have been surrounded by so many stones. How easy to end the suffering with such a miracle? Are there times when you have to say to yourself or someone else 'No!' even when what is being suggested is a good thing in itself?

Secondly, Jesus is offered power beyond measure if only he will worship the devil. Wow! To have power – this is something the oppressed yearn for and the rich think they already have. But at what price? The Lord's heart is focused totally on his Father - nothing and no-one will get in the way of this relationship of divine love. What do you face in your life which undermines your relationship of love with God? What can you do about it?

Finally, Jesus is encouraged to throw himself off the parapet of the Temple trusting that the angels will catch him and save him. Is this real faith or is it just a manipulation of a loving, compassionate Father? 'You must not put the Lord your God to the test' is Jesus' response. How does faith really touch your life and allow you to trust in God no matter what?

The devil is exhausted and unsuccessful! He will return at the appointed time when the Cross is imminent. As we journey through Lent will it be as easy for us or will the devil's temptations overcome us? Even if we feel we are getting somewhere, we must be ready to face the Cross and embrace the power of suffering revealed in God's Son's Death and Resurrection.

The next early Mass will be on Friday 4th March at 6.30am at St. Bonaventure's. The Lenten Reconciliation Service will be on Tuesday 22nd March at 8pm at Our Lady's.
