HOLY FAMILY

Fifth Sunday of Lent 13th March 2016 (page 176 of Mass book)

Stones are very prominent in today's Gospel reading from St. John! The passage has influenced the way we speak about 'casting the first stone' and is a huge challenge to us as 'religious' people and especially as followers of Christ. The crowd wants the poor woman to be put to death by having stones hurled at her. They shame her by dragging her before the Lord and put him on the spot by asking his opinion. Jesus seems more bothered by writing on the ground with his finger and chooses a few words to confound the mob: 'If there is one of you who has not sinned, let him be the first to throw a stone at her.' We are told by St. John that they started to leave one by one, beginning with the eldest. The final encounter displays pure mercy as Jesus says quite explicitly that he does not condemn the lady and asks her to go away and sin no more. What an amazing conclusion!

Jesus reveals the pure mercy of God. Jesus does not condemn but offers forgiveness. Jesus always lives out what he asks of us. For us as human beings it is hard to hold in balance the teaching which comes from the Bible (or the Church) with the reality of the situations in which we - or others - find our/themselves. There is such tension. When we succeed in being faithful, a danger is to fall into the trap of condemning others. We can use words which destroy someone's character or inflict deep pain. At times it is possible to feel that we are beyond God's forgiving reach because of a major sin committed which we just cannot forget. This passage challenges us to open up ourselves to the rich mercy of Father, Son and Spirit revealed in Jesus and, in turn, to offer it to those around us. Can we be like him who is the Face of the Father's mercy? Let's try!

Today another stone is being pondered as we welcome Cardinal Vincent Nichols to St. Bonaventure's to commemorate the 90th Anniversary of the Laying of the Foundation Stone. This was the first church to be built in Welwyn Garden City which has such strong Christian foundations. Jesus in Scripture refers to himself as the cornerstone, so stones do not have to bad! Indeed we are called to be the living stones of the Church. Some churches have a decorative stone which indicates the date and the Bishop who laid it. Others, like St. Bonaventure's, have the stone concealed. We do know that the Foundation Stone was laid on 10th March, 1926. From this first church have come Our Lady Queen of Apostles and Holy Family; the three form a strong Catholic community which is vibrant and engages with our Garden City. May God's eternal mercy touch us today and bring us all many blessings! *Fr.. Norbert*
