

Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion 20th March 2016 (page 184 of Mass book)

It's Palm Sunday! Time seems to have raced by even more quickly this year with the earlier Easter. Today we embark on the journey with Jesus to his Passion, Death and Resurrection. In St. John's Gospel we are often told that Jesus' *hour* has not yet come. Well now it has! He willingly sets on the path which will cost him his life. He is totally obedient to the Father. His loving mercy reaches out to bring forgiveness. His final breath into the unknown of Death is rewarded with Resurrection! *Time* this week takes us back to the events of the first Holy Week. *Time* this week points us to the future life of Heaven. *Time* this week is rooted in the reality of the NOW with past and future coming into our lives. Eternity comes into the present moment - Wow!

So what difference will the events unfolding this week make to your lives? I think, firstly, we must consider that the Death and Resurrection of Jesus marks out our identity as followers of Jesus. We should want to be people open to the grace which comes from the Cross, shaping our lives and bringing us forgiveness beyond measure. Secondly, all that we do and are this Holy Week is a sign to those around us of the hope which comes from the Cross: God loves each one of us, God forgives and saves, God offers eternal life. How can we share this divine reality with others? I am sure there are people who will ask us questions about what we are up to this week! Try and find words to explain what you are doing or trying to do. Don't forget that it is our actions which can speak even more persuasively and powerfully; so our readiness to forgive, to reach out to those in need, to commit ourselves to Christ, especially when his Cross weighs upon us, will radiate Faith which is alive.

Above all, let each one of us ponder the Mystery that Easter is *God's* work, his Blessing coming down upon the world, offering us renewal and strength.
