Today (Sunday) Mother Teresa of Calcutta will be declared a Saint by Pope Francis in St. Peter's. She died on 5th September, 1997 aged 87. It was soon after the death of Princess Diana. I remember a friend telling me that he was travelling on the Tube on that day and that the Tube driver made an announcement so that the everyone would know about Mother Teresa's death! I saw her once in Birmingham at the National Conference of Priests in the early 90's. She was a tiny figure in her sari-styled habit clutching her bag as she went along. She melted the hearts of so many that day - especially some of the more militant clergy who had gathered! We know that she went to the United Nations to collect the Nobel Prize for Peace. Through the work of her Missionaries of Charity, so many of the poorest of the poor have been offered a dignity beyond measure and loving care. *Saint Teresa of Calcutta...pray for us!*

HOLY FAMILY CHURCH FLOOR The crack in the floor of the main aisle, due to a former underfloor heating system, has now been repaired. The new floor will be laid in October and will cover the whole nave. As mentioned some time ago, this will entail the closing of the church for two weeks. It has been confirmed that the work will begin on Monday 3rd October and be completed by Tuesday 18th October. Next week's newsletter will explain where Mass will be celebrated in that period.

Children should be at least in Year 3 at school.

Preparation starts in November. **RCIA** If you are an adult who wish to join the Catholic Church or if you are a Catholic who missed out on Confirmation when younger and now feel ready to be confirmed, come to Our Lady's Sacristy on Monday 3rd October 7.30pm. There will be a chance to meet others and find out more about what is involved.

MARRIAGE PREPARATION DAY will be on Saturday 4th February in Our Lady's Hall. Couples who wish to get married here in WGC or in another place in 2017/18 are invited to come. Keep the date free. Breathe out Mercy' led by Bishop John Crowley, retired Bishop of Middlesbrough on Saturday 10th September for our Deanery in Our Lady's Hall, WGC. We will begin with Mass at 9.30am followed by coffee. The Day will end at 3pm. Please bring food to share at lunchtime.. This Day will provide a great time of enrichment for us all but especially Catechists, Eucharistic Ministers, Readers and Welcomers. Here in WGC in our parishes we will then have the Recommissioning of Ministers the following weekend (17th/18th September) at all the Masses.

CAFOD Herts Constabulary Choir are giving a concert at St Bonaventure's on Monday 26th September at 8pm tickets £5 each. The event is part of St Bonaventure's 90th year celebrations all proceeds from the event will be going to CAFOD.

ST. ALBANS Bishop John Sherrington will be preaching at an Ecumenical Evensong at St. Alban's Abbey Cathedral on Saturday 8th October at 4pm for this Year of Mercy. Bishop John would like all the schools of Hertfordshire to lead a procession from Verulamium Park at 2.30pm which will enter the Abbey and prepare for Evensong. Watch this space!

END OF YEAR OF MERCY In our Diocese the Doors of Mercy at the Cathedral will be closed at Vespers on Sunday 13th November. Here in WGC, the Doors at Our Lady's will be closed on Friday 18th November. Bishop Paul McAleenan will celebrate Mass at 7.30pm. In Rome Pope Francis will close the Doors of Mercy in St. Peter's on the Solemnity of Christ the King Sunday 20th November and formally conclude the Jubilee Year of Mercy.

BISHOPS' VISITS Two other Auxiliary Bishops of our Diocese will be coming to preach on Mercy at Our Lady's: Bishop John Wilson on Sunday 9th October at 11.30am and Bishop Nicholas Hudson on Sunday 30th October at 11.30am.

SECONDARY SCHOOL TRANSFER Fr. Norbert writes: It is important for parents to go to school open days/evenings with their children in September/October and see the options. Read the admissions criteria carefully to ensure you have a good chance of getting into the school if it is oversubscribed. Get hold of your child's Baptismal Certificate in good time. Think about the environment in which your child will flourish. In terms of the Certificate of Catholicity, the form will be given by the schools and will have to be signed by Fr. Norbert. The Certificate of Catholicity is a statement that the child comes from a practising Catholic family which means there is attendance at Mass every week. To facilitate this, Fr. Norbert will give out an 'extra' form for WGC parishes for parents to fill out for him. Meetings will be scheduled in early October when parent/s and child will come to meet with Fr. Norbert. These dates of the meetings will be published soon.

ALTAR SERVERS MASS The annual National Altar Servers Mass will be at Westminster Cathedral on Saturday 17th September 2pm for 2.30pm start. We will be going for this Mass and it would be great to have many of our servers. We will get the 12.53 train from WGC Station. Every server must be accompanied by a supervising adult and purchase their train tickets. After the Mass we will return to WGC for something to eat which will be on the parishes!

EDUCATION SUNDAY The Bishops of England and Wales have changed the day on which Education Sunday is marked and so it will be celebrated next Sunday (11th). Holy Family School will lead 9.30 Mass at Holy Family Church and Our Lady School will lead 11.30 Mass at Our Lady's Church. We look forward to welcoming children and parents, staff and governors to be with us for Sunday Mass.

MARRIAGE ENRICHMENT DAY for our Deanery will be on Saturday 24th September in Our Lady's Hall starting with Coffee at 10am and ending at 3pm. There will be Mass at 12noon with the Renewal of Marriage Vows. The Day will build on last year's WGC Parishes' Day and will be led by Edmund Adamus and his team.

The Parish Finance Committees will present accounts for the three churches. The Parish Advisory Council will share thoughts about the month of November and we will hear about World Youth Day.
